On April 24, 2007, Portland Parks and Recreation completed evaluation of responses on RFP # PKSO12 for The Fields Neighborhood Park Design and Construction. The Fields Neighborhood Park is located to the southwest of the Centennial Mills site as mentioned in Section 3 Site Information of the RFQ #06-27:

Currently, there is an at-grade railroad track crossing to the Property at NW 9th Avenue and Naito Parkway. A direct connection at either location linking Centennial Mills to the Fields Park is intended to provide a gateway and terminus to the River District parks system, enhance both open space facilities, and provide the neighborhood access to the waterfront and Willamette Greenway Trail.

The City of Portland intends to award The Fields Neighborhood Park Design and Construction contract to The Office of Cheryl Barton in San Francisco, CA. This award shall be final May 1, 2007. It is anticipated that the contract entered into with the City's selected design team will include conceptual design for a bridge connection from The Fields Neighborhood Park to the Centennial Mills site. It is also anticipated that the team selected as a result of the Centennial Mills Redevelopment RFQ #06-27 will coordinate closely with this selected firm.
